Isaiah's vision of a new shoot from Jesse's stump reminds us that God brings life even from what seems dead. Advent is a season of hope—trusting that God is doing something new in our lives. Paul urges us to live in peace and glorify God together. Advent is not only personal preparation but also communal—building bridges, forgiving, and fostering unity. This vision challenges us: Are we instruments of peace in our families, workplaces, and communities?

John the Baptist reminds us that faith is not lip service. It must bear fruit—acts of kindness, justice, and mercy. Advent invites us to examine our hearts and remove obstacles that block God's grace. His fiery words shake us out of complacency: Are we ready for Christ's coming, or are we clinging to comfort and pride? Perhaps as part of our Advent we could spend time in prayer and silence—like the desert where John preached—to hear God's voice or make a concrete act of repentance: forgive someone, reconcile, or let go of a harmful habit.

*Lord Jesus Christ, come into our hearts and homes, remove all that divides us, and teach us to walk in Your ways of justice and harmony. May this light remind us that Your peace is stronger than fear and darkness.*
